- How do we really know that Jesus is the Son of God?

- How do we really know Christianity is the one true religion?

Think About It: If Jesus did rise from the dead, and the evidence (both biblical and secular) argues that He did, Jesus is the Son of God, the only Savior... and all the world must come to Him in true repentance and faith, or they will suffer the eternal judgment of God in hell.

His disciples spent the rest of their lives preaching the gospel of Jesus Christ. All endured severe persecution. All but John died violent deaths

from the enemies of the gospel.
