Who's in Charge in the Home? (Eph. 6:1-4)

Intro: The husband/wife relationship is often plagued with conflict, but there is a second relationship in the home that can be even more troubling—the parent/child relationship.

1. A Word to the Children

vs. 1-3

- Obey your parents.
 - "in the Lord—This is what God DESIRES and DEMANDS.
 - "this is right"—This command is based on GOD'S standard of right.

Questions:

How old are "children"?

What if the parents aren't very "smart"?...or godly?

What if obeying one's parents would mean disobeying God?

Honor your parents.

- "so that it may be well with you"—refers to QUALITY of life
- "so that you may live long on the earth"—refers to QUANTITY of life

2. A Word to the Parents

v. 4

- "Do not provoke your children to anger".
- Do "bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord".
